# **NAVY UDT-SEAL MUSEUM SILENT AUCTION**

Fort Pierce, FL October 12, 2009 – The National Navy UDT-SEAL Museum is currently hosting a silent auction to benefit the Museum and the Navy SEAL Memorial. The showpiece of this auction is a necklace and earring set, with a retail value of \$1700, of matching gold and emeralds. The set is comprised of three, oval cut, Colombian emeralds (4.24 carats total weight) mounted in 14K white gold settings. The necklace is comprised of a single emerald on a 16", 14K, yellow gold, chain. This custom-made jewelry was donated by Sandra L. Riper of Sunset Hill Jewelers in West Chester, PA, Mr. Dave Godshall of Vero Beach, FL, and Mr. Dave Kohler of West Chester, PA. Bidding for these items is now open, and the silent auction will end at 3PM on Saturday, November 7, 2009. Immediately after the close of the silent auction, the items will be auctioned off live.

The National Navy UDT-SEAL Museum is the only museum dedicated solely to preserving the history of the Navy SEALs and their predecessors, including the Underwater Demolition Teams, Naval Combat Demolition Units, Office of Strategic Services Maritime Units and Amphibious Scouts and Raiders. Located in Fort Pierce, Florida - the birthplace of the Navy Frogman - the Museum promotes public education by providing the opportunity to explore the history of the Navy SEALs in an atmosphere of respect and honor.
